

LEMTA ANNOUNCES ROCKIN' NEW BOAT SHOW

The Lake Erie Marine Trades Association has announced it's set to "Rock the Dock" with a new in-water boat show at the North Coast Harbor in downtown Cleveland (OH), September 15-17.

Officially named the North Coast Harbor Boat Show, LEMTA's newest event will be adjacent to Cleveland's iconic Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. The show will take over all the popular transient docks, appropriately dubbed the Rock & Dock Marina, that boaters flock to each year to visit downtown Cleveland, and access major sports events in adjacent FirstEnergy Stadium and nearby Progressive Field.

"It's an opportunity for our dealers to showcase their boats in an exceptional location right in the heart of our major market city," explained LEMTA president Bryan Ralston. "The atmosphere in this harbor is one of energy and activity, not just because the fabulous Rock Hall is there, but it's also surrounded by the Great Lakes Science Center, the floating Steamship William G. Mather Museum, the USS Cod submarine museum, the Nuevo Restaurant and more."

Ralston says there will be about 100 boats displayed in the water from about 20 feet to 56 feet. Moreover, the marina's configuration allows easy access for dealers wishing to provide sea trials and demonstrations.

Admission is FREE. Show hours will be: Friday 11 a.m.-9 p.m.; Saturday Noon-9 p.m.; Sunday 12-6 p.m.
